30 TAC §335, Subchapter Q requirements

ROBERT PUGA PG:

You are receiving this letter because we have identified your facility as subject to the Waste Reduction Policy Act (WRPA). WRPA applies to facilities that are large quantity generators (LQG) of hazardous waste, small quantity generators (SQG) of hazardous waste, and/or facilities that are Toxics Release Inventory (TRI) Form R reporters.

Facilities subject to WRPA must prepare a five-year Pollution Prevention (P2) Plan and submit the Executive Summary to the TCEQ. If your facility is a conditionally exempt small quantity generator of hazardous waste and does not report on the TRI Form R, please contact the P2 program to update your status. If you are registered as an SQG, LQG, and/or report on TRI Form R, you must complete your P2 Plan and you must submit the Executive Summary to the TCEQ by January 1, 2017.
