RE: Renewal of Exemption from 30 TAC 335.471-335.480 for PROJECT NAVIGATOR LTD CUSTODIAL TRUSTEE TEXAS CUST, ASARCO, P2 ID P00045

Dear ROBERTO PUGA:

The facility above has been granted renewal of its exemption from the above-referenced Waste Reduction Policy Act requirements for calendar year 2017. This exemption will require annual renewal.

The decision to grant an exemption is based on the standards and criteria in 30 TAC 335.477(2). These standards and criteria are:

1. The facility has reduced the amount of pollutants and contaminants being generated or released by 90% since the base year;
2. Potential impact on human health and the environment of any remaining hazardous waste generated, or pollutant or contaminant released; and
3. A demonstration that additional reductions are not economically and technically feasible.
